Over the course of this semester, several challenges were encountered that impacted the overall learning experience. Notably, there was a significant degree of miscommunication among the faculty members. This inconsistency often resulted in confusion regarding assignment deadlines, lecture content, and examination expectations.

Moreover, the clarity of the output required for various assignments and projects was frequently lacking. Students found it difficult to understand the exact requirements and criteria for evaluation, which led to unnecessary stress and uncertainty

In light of these issues, it is recommended that steps be taken to improve communication among the faculty and to provide more detailed and explicit guidelines for coursework Enhanced coordination and clearer communication and constructive criticism can greatly entribute to a more effective and supportive learning environment.

I would like to say, that the way everything was handled in this semester was terrible. There was no co-ordination between all the facilities. The integrated studio was not planned end executed properly. Also, we were told that we are going to study maheshwar for the urban design studio, and were forced to go to Kolhapur, with the reason being attendence. I don't understand the co-relation between location and attendance. You could have changed location for the people who you think to be attending lower than expected (in second year we already had different people with different settlement area-kudase and kudje , why not this sem also?). Next, there should have been a single mentor for each group, it was very difficult to manage the thinking process of different faculty, which was opposing each other. The integrated part of auditorium felt very forced, and didn't match with the intent of the Urban design project. There was a constant to and from going on between the abost team and design team, which made out project hand in air for a very long time, the time which could be used to develop the project in a better way. The abos faculty tried to intervene in the urban design which was not going good for most of the groups. And they were also not able to teach the technicalities required for a auditorium.

2.)Regarding periodic uploads of Assignments.


