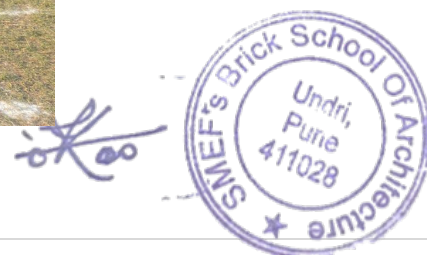

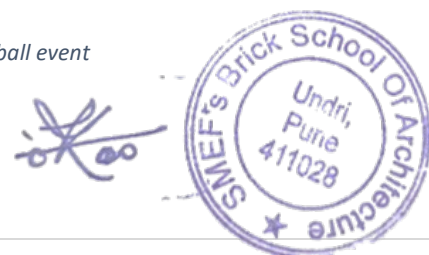

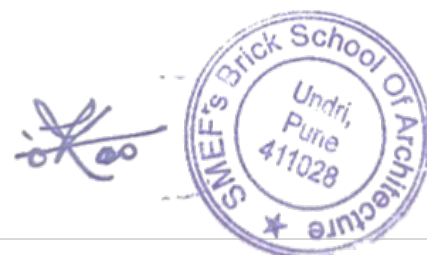

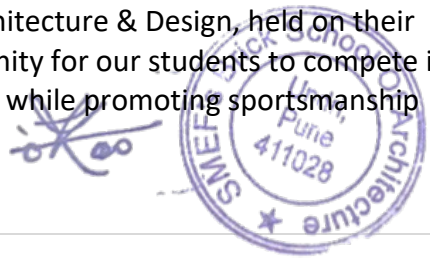
Figure 15 Invitation letter to Principal

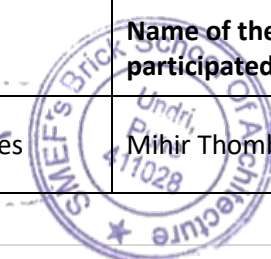

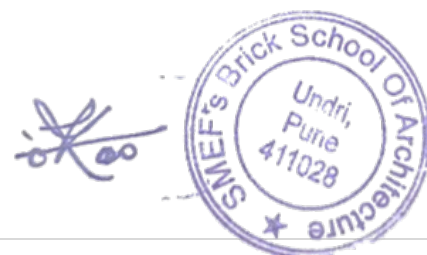

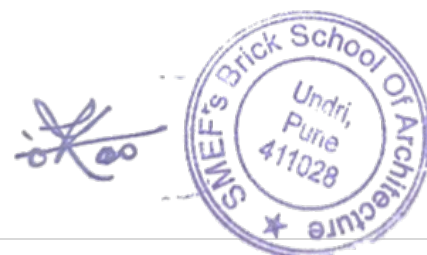



Figure 18 Ateletics Medals- 17 medals (2 Gold, 9 silver, 6 bronze)

On the occasion of International Women’s Day- a day to celebrate the feminine - Architect Pritika Manjarekar had shared her insights on how to lead an organization with tools built on the principle of yin-yang leadership.

Summary of the speech and presentation:

Women's participation in architectural practice has been a topic of discussion in the event. While the number of women in architecture has increased over the past few decades, there are still many challenges that women face in this profession.

One of the main challenges is the issue of gender bias and discrimination. Women often face barriers in terms of job opportunities, pay, and advancement within firms. There is also a lack of female role models in the field, which can make it difficult for women to envision themselves as successful architects. RAISING THE INDIAN FLAG

Ar. Atul Rajwade is known for his extensive work in long span steel structures. He is the owner of Third Wave Design firm, Pune. He has worked with Sandeep Mahajan and Associates where he worked on 1st Slum Rehabilitation Project for Pune City and 1st Pune Riverfront Development Project Proposal.

He has studied in IDC, IIT Bombay for M.Des. Course in product design. While studying, he assisted Prof. Gogate from IIT Aerospace Dept. in Designing and developing the cockpit and pilot sitting arrangement for the IIT Bombay experimental Aircraft. He has designed many lightweight long-span structures and now he is working on 6 creek bridges for MSRTC for the Western Coastal Highway stretch from Mumbai to Jaigad. He is also enthusiastically involved in academics.

The Western Naval Command of the Indian Navy had exhibited **the world's largest national flag at Mumbai's Naval Dockyard**, overlooking the iconic Gateway of India, on Navy Day, as part of 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav' on Saturday. The flag measured 225 feet in length and 150 feet in width and weighed about 1400 kgs and is made of khadi and was manufactured in 49 days with 70 Khadi artisans to prepare this flag. This monumental structure is a tensile structure and it supports the Indian flag which is almost 34000 sq. Ft. This structure was designed and executed in a record time of one month by Third Wave Design.

The event included panel discussion discourse and presentation on “Architects who built the Nation”. The special event on this day was an online session by Ar. Atul Rajwade on "Structural system of India's largest flag exhibited at Indian Navy dockyard". The Western Command of the Indian Navy exhibited the world’s largest national flag at Mumbai’s Naval Dockyard, overlooking the iconic Gateway of India. This flag is 225’ long and 150’ wide. The structural system weighs 1400 kgs and the fabric of the flag is made of Khadi. Making such a big installation in the difficult site condition was a challenge and Ar. Atul Rajwade has set a landmark example by the design and installation of this system. He explained the whole journey of its design and transportation and installation.

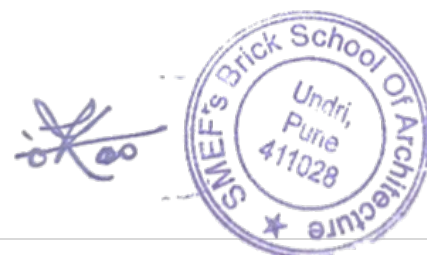
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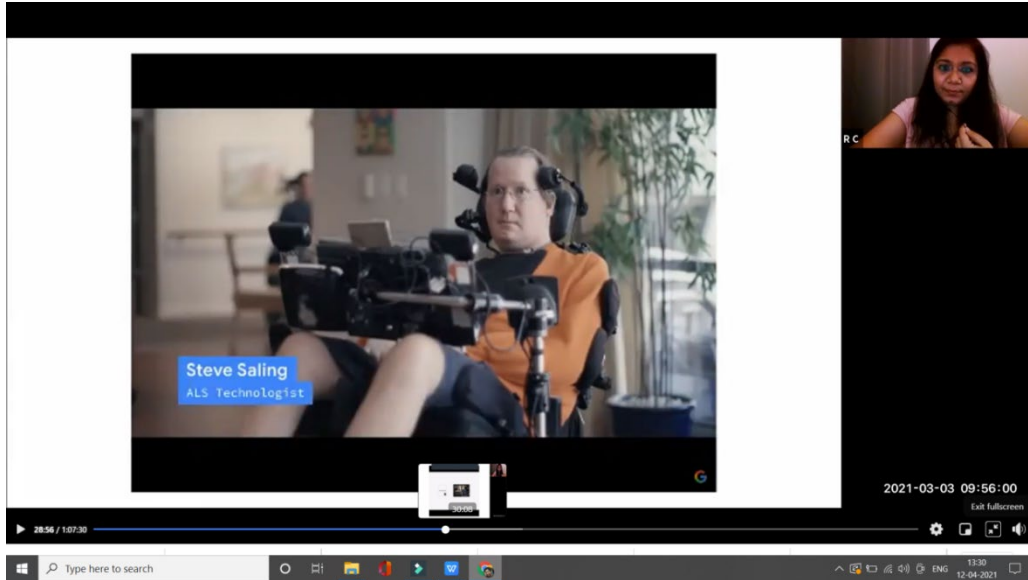
Brief of the Session:

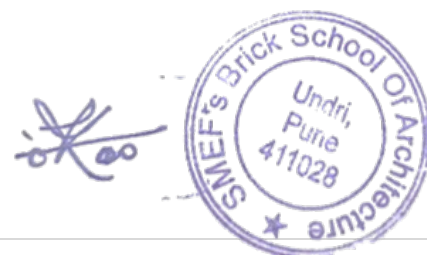

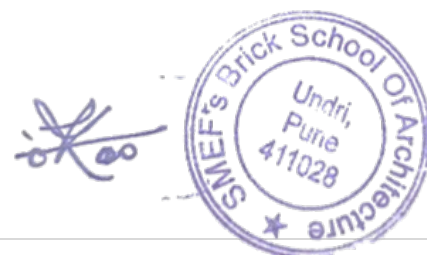

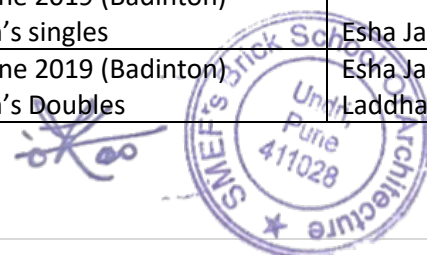



Figure 29 Esha Jagtap and Urja Laddha with the trophy and the certificate for the First place in women's doubles

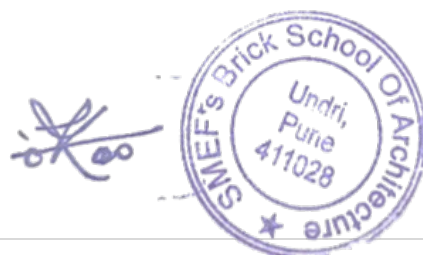

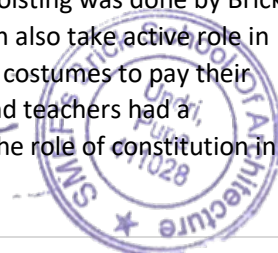
